## PIT SAFETY INSPECTION (PSI)

### Pit Crew

Pass     Fail     Fix     Fixed

- All pit members must have wrist bands, teams are responsible to police your own pit area (1.7.3)

### Fire Safety

Pass     Fail     Fix     Fixed

- UL approved 20lb ABC Fire extinguisher or combination that equals 20lbs (1.7.6)
  - o Extinguisher combination example: one 20 lb., two 10 lb., or four 5 lb.
- Fueling safety gear for team members actively involved in refueling must comply with rule (1.7.11)

### Fueling Containment

Pass     Fail     Fix     Fixed

- All fuel cans kept off native soil and stored in a secondary containment system(1.7.8)
  - o *Secondary Containment:* plastic pool, raised edge fuel mat, fuel storage containment container
- Fuel Mat/Tarp (1.7.9)
- Fuel mat/tarp free from defects or tears (1.7.10)
- Fuel tarp requires absorption product on top (1.7.10)
- **REMINDER** – Fuel mats with raised boarder do not require adsorption product but is recommended (1.7.10)
- **REMINDER** – Teams responsible for ALL fuel spills and may be fined or liable for clean-up expense (1.7.10)

### Vehicle Fueling

Pass     Fail     Fix     Fixed

- Vented fuel cans or gravity fed fuel tower at atmospheric pressure only (1.7.11)
- Overhead fuel towers (if used) located at least 50' from course and complies with rule (1.7.11)
- **REMINDER** – NO pressurized fueling system allowed (1.7.11)
- **REMINDER** – ALL fueling done over mat or tarp (1.7.10)
- **REMINDER** – No vehicle shall be refueled outside approved pit (1.7.9)
- **REMINDER** – Any team refueling outside an approved pit location may face disqualification. (1.7.10)
- **REMINDER** – A team member must man a fire extinguisher and in attendance during fuel transfer (1.7.11)
- **REMINDER** – NO other work may be performed while fueling in taking place (1.7.13)

### Other Pit Crew Reminders

- Chase crews must stay within designated race areas (1.7.1)
- Maximum speed limit in pit area is 25 mph (1.7.4)
- All teams are responsible for cleaning their pit area used during the event (1.7.7)
